***Pit area wristbands must be worn at all times while in pit area.
Only four people per car allowed in pit area with issued wristbands.
WILL BE STRICKLY INFORCED, NO ONE UNDER 12 YEARS OLD ALLOWED IN PITS!!!
NO ENTRY FEE FOR CARS, BUT EVERYONE PAYS ADMISSION. ***

RULES & REGULATIONS for Figure 8 (same as Demo Derby)

NEW: All drive tires MUST be straight tread only (NO EXCEPTIONS!) This rule is an extra effort keep dirt and debris from being thrown into the stands.

1. Drivers must be 18 years of age. 16 & 17 year olds may enter with official release form signed by parent or guardian.
2. All drivers and cars must be entered and at the track 1 hour before the scheduled starting time of derby.
3. Any driver not obeying the rules will be disqualified.
4. Your car numbers will be issued on approval of your application.
5. Each driver must fill out entry blanks.
6. All rules and regulations must be observed.
7. Only owners, drivers, and mechanics will be permitted in the pit area or on the track. This covers drivers and mechanics. No more than 4 people permitted per car in pit area. Everyone in pit area must have authorized wristband and a max of 4 per entry. **(NO ONE UNDER 12 YEARS OLD ALLOWED IN PITS).**
8. No cars permitted on the track before the heat they are to participate in.
9. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES allowed in pits. A random sobriety test will be given to drivers – failure to take the test if asked, will mean immediate disqualification. Of course, if intoxicated you will not be allowed to drive.**
10. All cars must be removed from grounds by the owner no later than 6:00 pm Monday, September 18th or they become the property of the Fairgrounds – No Exceptions.
11. All glass and chrome trim and anything that might become imbedded in the track, must be removed from the car before bringing auto to the grounds. Also car must be cleaned out including the trunk. Don't leave broken glass in doors, clean them out. Windshield is optional.
12. Safety belts and helmets are required. All doors must be welded shut or tied with rope or wire. If a driver's side door comes open, he will be disqualification.
13. No deliberate head-on collisions or deliberately ramming driver's door. This can lead to disqualifications.
14. Hood and trunk lids can be welded shut – But must have a minimum 6-inch inspection hole in truck lid.
15. A 12 by 15 inch hole must be cut in the center of the hood.
16. Safety rules and regulations are subject to change to fit the event. The decision of the judges is final.
17. A maximum of 5 gallons of gas will be allowed. Gas tanks must be moved inside car and covered by a firewall. All gas tanks left on the car must be empty with visible hole in bottom of tank to prove it. Tank can be removed completely. Only 1 stock car battery will be allowed.

Additional Rules & Regulations for Figure 8 Only:

18. 1. It is recommended that all cars including compacts have some type of driver compartment safety reinforcing. **IT MUST BE OF PROFESSIONAL QUALITY AND WORKMANSHIP.** NOTE: NO GRADER BLADES OR TEMPERED STEEL THAT MAY SHATTER IS ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON CAR.
2. Max 109" wheel base (NO FULL SIZE CARS ALLOWED IN FIGURE 8 RACE).
3. DO NOT have NUMBERS mounted on cars, we will issue magnetic roof marker for each heat.
NEW: NO BRACING BEYOND THE CENTER FLAT PART OF THE FRAME. NO METAL OR STEEL PLATES CAN BE ADDED TO FRONT BUMPER SECTION THAT CAN BE CONSIDERED FRAME REINFORCING. (INCLUDING WELDING OF HOOD TO BUMPER).
