## Friday Night Compact Cars

**MAXIMUM 104" WHEEL BASE**

- All must Preregister to assure A SPOT.
- **ONLY** 1<sup>st</sup> 24 cars to enter and preregister will receive \$100 and a Trophy.
- Depending on participation there may be 1 or 2 derby's with a **TOTAL** purse of \$1,500.
- Rules and regulations are the same as full size except maximum wheel base of 104 inches.  
NOTE: Fuel tank rule does not apply to compact cars unless tank is located behind rear wheels.  
NOTE: Winner can run SATURDAY NIGHT IN MIDSIZE IF DESIRED.

## Friday Night Full Size Cars

**MUST PREREGISTER**

- There will be a limit of **12** cars to run 1 derby, 1st **12** to register and compete will receive \$100 and Trophy.
- Purse will be determined by entries at a rate of \$100 per car. Example 12 cars \$1,200 total purse, 10 cars \$1,000 etc. PAYOUT 1<sup>st</sup> place 70% of purse and Trophy, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 30% of purse and Trophy.
- All rules and regulations apply. (**READ CAREFULLY**)

## Saturday Night Midsize Cars

**MAXIMUM 109" WHEEL BASE**

- All must Preregister to assure a SPOT.
- **ONLY** 1<sup>st</sup> 24 cars to enter and preregister will receive \$100 and a Trophy.
- Depending on participation there may be 1 or 2 derby's with a **TOTAL** purse of \$1,500.
- Rules and regulations are the same as full size except maximum wheel base of 109 inches.  
NOTE: Fuel tank rules does not apply to Midsize cars unless tank is located behind rear wheels.

## Saturday Night Compact Cars

**MAXIMUM 104" WHEEL BASE**

- Will be run before MIDSIZE cars.
- NO registration necessary **ONLY** Compacts that run Friday Night (excluding winner) will be allowed in this derby NO purse just 1<sup>ST</sup> & 2<sup>ND</sup> place trophies and winner can run in MIDSIZE DERBY IF DESIRED.

**\*Pit area wristbands must be worn at all times while in pit area.  
Only four people per car allowed in pit area with issued wristbands.  
NO ENTRY FEE FOR CARS, BUT EVERYONE PAYS ADMISSION.\***

## **\*RULES & REGULATIONS\***

**NEW RULE: Drivers Door Only Painted White or Orange (Different from Car Color)**

**ALL CARS MUST PREREGISTER**

**NEW: ALL DRIVE TIRES MUST BE STRAIGHT TREAD ONLY (NO EXCEPTIONS)**

### **Full size, Midsize, Compacts:**

1. Drivers must be 18 years of age. 16 & 17 year olds may enter with official release form signed by parent or guardian.
2. All drivers and cars must be entered and at the track 1 hour before the scheduled starting time of derby.
3. Any driver not obeying the rules will be disqualified.
4. Your car numbers will be issued on approval of your application.
5. Each driver must fill out entry blanks.
6. All rules and regulations must be observed.
7. **NEW PIT LAYOUT FOR 2018!!!** Only owners, drivers, and mechanics will be permitted in the pit area or on the track. This covers drivers and mechanics. No more than 4 people permitted per car in pit area. Everyone in pit area must have authorized wristband and a max of 4 per entry. **(NO ONE 12 YEARS OLD OR YOUNGER ALLOWED IN PIT AREA).**
8. No cars permitted on the track before the heat they are to participate in.
9. **NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES allowed in pits. A random sobriety test will be given to drivers – failure to take the test if asked, will mean immediate disqualification. Of course, if intoxicated you will not be allowed to drive.**
10. All cars must be removed from grounds by the owner no later than 6:00 pm Monday, September 24<sup>th</sup> or they become the property of the Fairgrounds – No Exceptions.
11. All glass and chrome trim and anything that might become imbedded in the track, must be removed from the car before bringing auto to the grounds. Also car must be cleaned out including the trunk. Don't leave broken glass in doors, clean them out. Windshield is optional.
12. Safety belts and helmets are required. All doors must be welded shut or tied with rope or wire. If a driver's side door comes open, he will be disqualification.
13. Drivers may maneuver forward or backward. No deliberate head-on collisions or deliberately ramming driver's door. This can lead to disqualifications.
14. A time limit will be set by the judges. If a driver does not hit a live car within the time limit, this can lead to disqualification. Do not play possum.
15. Hood and trunk lids can be welded shut – But must have a minimum 6-inch inspection hole in truck lid.
16. A 12 by 15 inch hole must be cut in the center of the hood.
17. Safety rules and regulations are subject to change to fit the event. The decision of the judges is final.
18. **IMPORTANT NEW SAFETY RULES – If a driver breaks his flag, do not hit his car. If a car is not moving, do not take aim at the driver's compartment from any direction. A violation of either can lead to disqualification.**
19. No Chrysler Imperials, Hearses, or Limousines allowed
20. No trucks, jeeps, etc. will be allowed.
21. A maximum of 5 gallons of gas will be allowed. Gas tanks must be moved inside car and covered by a firewall. All gas tanks left on the car must be empty with visible hole in bottom of tank to prove it. Tank can be removed completely. Only 1 stock car battery will be allowed.
22. **NEW!!! NO BRACING BEYOND THE CENTER FLAT PART OF THE FRAME. NO METAL OR STEEL PLATES CAN BE ADDED TO FRONT BUMPER SECTION THAT CAN BE CONSIDERED FRAME REINFORCING. (INCLUDING WELDING OF HOOD TO BUMPER). BUMPERS MUST BE OF BUMPER MATERIAL. NO STEEL PIPES, STRUCTURAL STEEL, TUBING ETC.**
